The Value of Eco-Labels

- <u>EPEAT:</u> Released in 2007 with 0 Gold products. Today, there are 495 Gold products (more than 1/3 of total EPEAT registered products)
- <u>ClimateCounts</u>: All companies improved!

10 Step Program

- Step 1: Form a Team
- Step 2: Gather Baseline Data
- <u>Step 3: Choose the Best Equipment Mix</u>
- Step 4: Decide on Acquisition Method
- Step 5: Set Goals
- Step 6: Adopt a Policy
- Step 7: Evaluate Standards and Specs
- Step 8: Improve Practices
- Step 9: Measure Progress
- Step 10: Report Success and Award Efforts



Step 3: Choose the Best Equipment Mix

- <u>Buy Remanufactured Toner and Inkjet Cartridges-</u> <u>Save \$\$\$</u>
- No More Analog Machines
- Reduce Inkjet Printing
- Connect Printers and Copiers to Computer Networks
- Use Color Only When Necessary
- Explore Multifunction Devices (MFDs)
- Consider Remanufactured Equipment





Step 8: Improve Practices

- Buying is first step. Usage is next!
- General Tenets:
 - Manage as much information as possible electronically
 - Print only what is necessary at the lowest cost and using devices with the lowest environmental and health impacts
 - Store printed documents to be easily found instead of reprinted



Make Duplexing Mandatory!

- Save up to 40% on paper costs use the extra money to buy 100% recycled paper
- Set up the equipment
 - First, work with IT dept. to set all printers to "doublesided"
 - Then, do the same with copiers. "Two-sided" to "Twosided is an effective default mode
- Train Staff
 - Explain that single-sided is still available
 - Pre-printed letterheads need to be fed



Examine Printing Needs and Workflows

- Switch to Electronic Workflows
- Reduce the Number of Printed Documents
- Change the way Printed Documents are Used
- File Paper Documents Better
