

Opportunities to Earn STARS Points With RPN Purchasing Guides

The Sustainability Tracking, Assessment & Rating System (STARS) is a transparent, self-reporting framework for colleges and universities to recognize and gauge relative progress toward sustainability. Through purchasing, institutions may earn credits in Education & Research (ER) and Operations (OP) credit categories.

The chart below highlights ways in which purchasing can help your institution earn points toward STARS ratings.

Education and Research (ER) 2	Student Sustainability Outreach Campaign	Example of qualified campaign: A challenge to reduce bottled drinking water leads to purchasing less bottled water and more reuseable containers.	5/5	<u>Bottled water - University</u> <u>Edition; Computers;</u> <u>Lighting</u>
Operations (OP) 1	Building Operations & Maintenance	Usage of environmentally preferable materials and products. This credit is designed to recognize LEED certification.	7/7	Link to RPN LEED chart
OP 2	Building Design & Construction	Usage of environmentally preferable materials and products. This credit is also designed to recognize LEED certification.	4/4	Link to RPN LEED chart
OP 5	Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction	Usage of various green products that reduce GHG emissions. Purchasing of third-party verified carbon offsets also apply.	14/14	<u>Carbon Offsets</u>
OP 6	Food Purchasing	Purchase food from local, organic and/or sustainable sources.	6/6	Food Services
OP Tier Two	Dining Services	Purchase food packaging and serviceware that is biodegradeable, recyclable, reusable, or compostable.	1.25/2.5	Food Services

OP 7	Building Energy Consumption	Purchase of more energy efficient products.	8/8	Office Electronics; Computers; LEDs; Lighting
OP 8	Renewable Energy	Purchase of wind power or other green energy.	7/7	<u>Green Power</u>
OP Tier Two	Energy Tier Two Credits	Purchase of LED lights and other energy saving or monitoring devices.	1/1.5	LEDs; Lighting; Office Electronics; Computers
OP 10	Computer Purchasing	Purchase of EPEAT Silver or higher products.	2/2	<u>Computers;</u> Office <u>Electronics</u>
OP 11	Cleaning Products Purchasing	Purchase of GreenSeal or EcoLogo certified products.	2/2	<u>Cleaners</u>
OP 12	Office Paper Purchasing	Purchase of office paper with specified recycled content.	2/2	<u>Paper</u>
OP 14	Campus Fleet	Purchase of electric , hybrid, hydrogen, biodiesel, or ethanol vehicles.	2/2	<u>Fleets</u>
OP 17	Waste Reduction	Purchase remanufactured toner cartridges; eliminate bottled water purchasing.	1/5	Bottled Water - University Edition; Toner Cartridges; Office Electronics
Innovation (IN) 1	Innovation Credit	Example: Eliminate bottled water purchasing and implement alternatives.	1/1	<u>Bottled Water - University</u> <u>Edition</u>

Note that this chart includes only the credit categories for which the act of purchasing may earn STARS points. Institutions may earn up to an estimated 21% (63.5 out of 304 maximum points) of STARS points through the purchases associated with the above credit categories and by meeting other criteria.

Purchasing can (and should) also play an indirect or planning role in many other credit categories, such as:

- Vendor Code of Conduct (OP 13)
- Sustainability Plan (Planning, Administration and Engagement PAE 4)
- Climate Plan (PAE 5)
- Sustainability Policy Advocacy (PAE 24)
